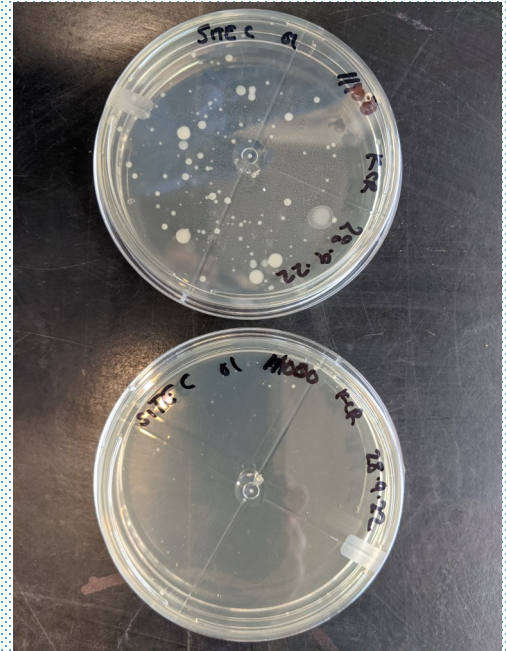
Second-year cell biology course transferrable to most Canadian Universities as a core course in BSc in biology
